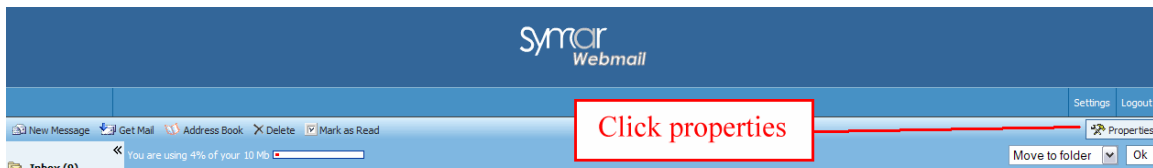


Webmail Instructions



After you login, click Properties in the top right hand corner.
